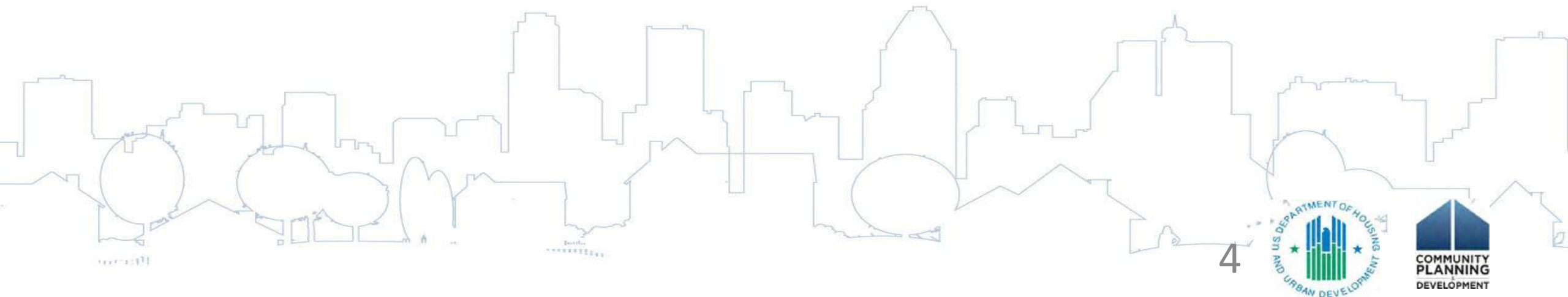

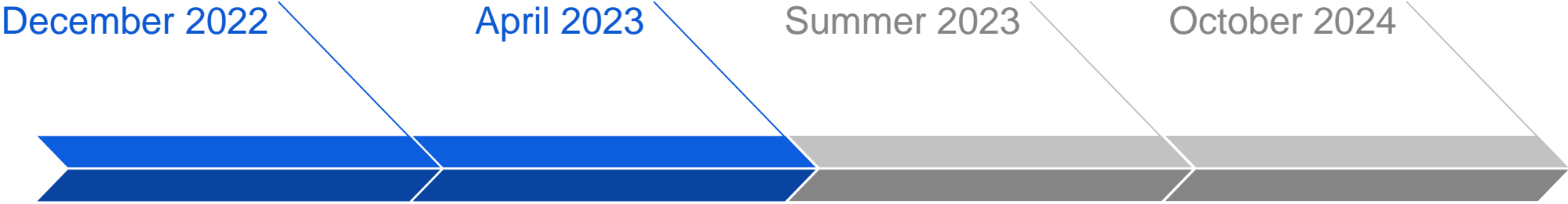

Finalize and Release

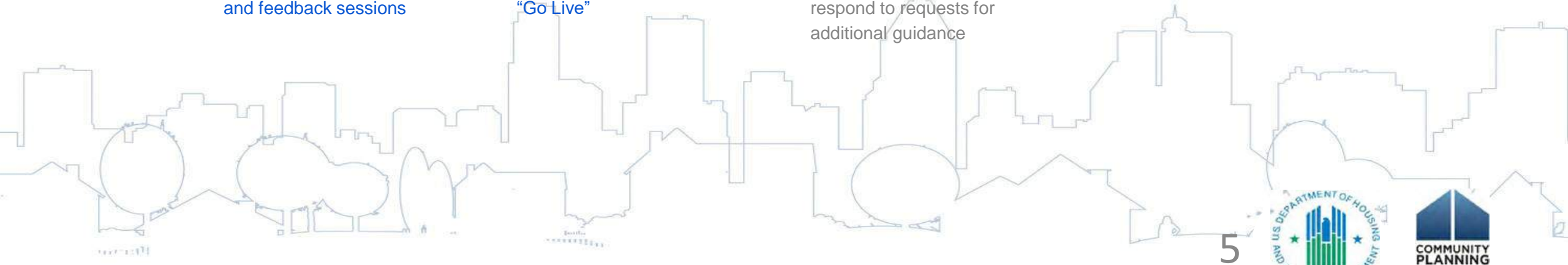
Goal is to give HMIS Vendors and HMIS Leads 6 months to implement prior to "Go Live"

Answer Questions & Provide Guidance

As the FY 2024 changes are processed locally, HUD and Federal Partner SMEs will respond to requests for additional guidance

Go Live

October 1, 2023 is the "Go Live" date for the HMIS Data Standards.

- HUD and their federal partners will make the final call on accepting or rejecting any proposed changes to the FY 2024 Data Standards.

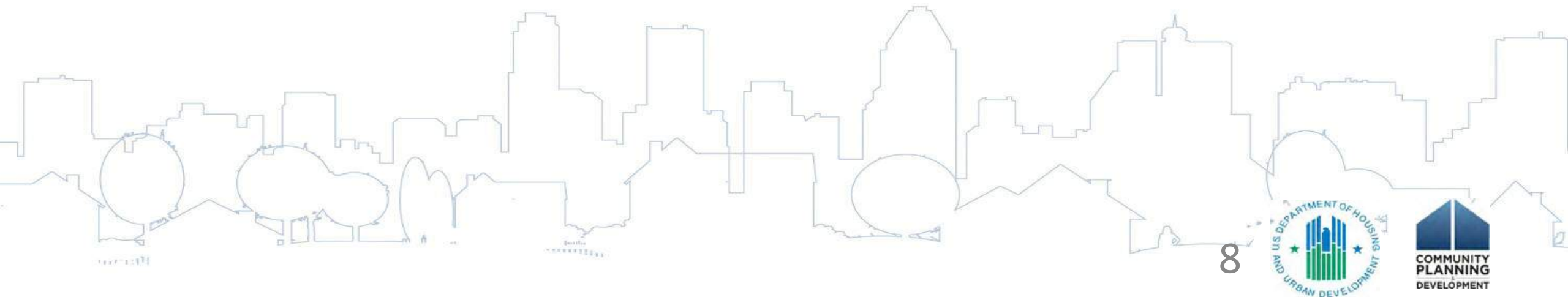
